### TRPA to discuss TMDLs

EASTON The Talbot River Protection Association is pleased to invite their members and the public to a discussion by a panel of experts, including representatives from the Maryland Department of the Environment and the Maryland Department of Agriculture, an agricultural scientist and the riverkeeper for Talbot County rivers, on the impact of Total Maximum Daily Loads on Talbot County's rivers and creeks on May 20.

So what is a TMDL? The Maryland Department derives power from the Federal Clean Water Act of 1972 requiring the department to regulate or set limits for the quantity of polluting substances entering the waterways.

The moderator of the panel will be Timothy D. Junkin, executive director of the Choptank River and Eastern Bay Conservancy. Questions may be asked of the panel.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 20, at the Talbot County Historical Society Auditorium, 25 S. Washington St., Easton, starting at 6 p.m. Wine and cheese will be served.
